



Soprano provides an extraordinary amount of space for a yacht of her size. She has a luxurious owner's suite, a full-beam VIP and two guest cabins flanked by ensuite bathrooms and featuring a Pullman bed recessed in the ceiling.

The master suite has a king-size bed, lots of storage space and a vanity. The large bathroom contains a multifunctional exercise machine with a raised ceiling that ensures ample headspace for comfortable workouts.

Accommodation for between four and seven crew members allows for a great ratio of staff to guests during chartering operations.


